Prevail Bank donates \$5,000 to First Presbyterian's Free Clinic



A donation of \$5,000 was made to the First Presbyterian Church of Wausau by Prevail Bank to help cover the expense of medical supplies needed by its Free Clinic on Grand Avenue, in addition to a clinic coordinator position.

This Spring, Prevail Bank's Charitable Contributions Committee approved the disbursement of \$67,650 between 20 nonprofits.
